Overview

You can use the `/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/modify_accounts` script to set existing cPanel accounts to use a new theme.

The `/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/modify_accounts` script

To use this script, run the following command as the `root` user:

```
/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/modify_accounts --theme=theme_name [options]
```

Note:

In this example, `theme_name` represents the name of the theme to which you wish to set for the package.

Arguments

The `/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/modify_accounts` script accepts the following arguments:

Option	Description	Example
<code>--theme</code>	Required The theme name that you wish to assign to the account. Specify the <code>paper_lantern</code> theme or the name of another valid theme that exists on the server.	<pre>/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/modify_accounts --theme=paper_lantern</pre>
<code>--users</code>	A comma-separated list of the cPanel accounts that you wish to modify.	<pre>/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/modify_accounts --theme=paper_lantern --users=user1,user2</pre>

<pre>--all-users</pre>	<p>Update all of the cPanel accounts that exist on the server.</p>	<pre>/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/modify_accounts --theme=paper_light --all-users</pre>
<pre>--all-users-from-reseller</pre>	<p>Update all of the cPanel accounts that a specific reseller owns.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid orange; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Note: This argument only accepts one reseller value.</p> </div>	<pre>/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/modify_accounts --theme=paper_light --all-users-from-reseller=reseller</pre>
<pre>--style</pre>	<p>The style that you wish to use for the specified theme.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specify a cPanel-provided system-level theme (<code>basic</code>, <code>retro</code>, <code>dark</code>, or <code>light</code>) or a style that exists in the <code>/var/cpanel/customizations</code> directory. • If you specify a style name that exists both as a system-level theme and in the <code>/var/cpanel/customizations</code> directory, the script will use the <code>/var/cpanel/customizations</code> directory's style. 	<pre>/usr/local/cpanel/scripts/modify_accounts --theme=paper_light --all-users --style=basic</pre>
