- **UAPI (recommended)** — `Ftp::addftp` — This function creates an FTP account.
- **cPanel API 2** — `Ftp::addftp` — This function creates an FTP account.

Important:

In cPanel & WHM version 76 and later, when you disable the FTP role, the system **disables** this function. For more information, read our [How to Use Server Profiles](#) documentation.
