Overview

With a cPanel Solo license, WHM users can manage a single cPanel account from the WHM interface. However, the cPanel Solo license limits the functionality that you would receive with a standard license.

Warnings:

- The cPanel Solo license **requires** cPanel & WHM version **66.0.25** or later.
- We **do not** support a downgrade from a Dedicated or VPS license to a cPanel Solo license.

Removed interfaces

Servers that use a cPanel Solo license will not display the following interfaces:

If you require these interfaces, upgrade your license to the full version.

Section name	Interfaces	Description
Security Center	<i>Compiler Access</i>	This interface allows you to disable your users' access to the C and C++ compilers on your server.
Resellers	<i>Modify an Account</i> (formerly <i>Change Ownership of an Account</i>).	This interface allows you to make changes to an existing account.
	<i>Change Ownership of Multiple Accounts</i>	This interface allows you to transfer multiple accounts to a reseller.
	<i>Email All Resellers</i>	This interface allows you to email every cPanel reseller simultaneously.
	<i>Manage Reseller's IP Delegation</i>	This interface allows you to control a reseller's access to the server's IP addresses.
	<i>Manage Reseller's Shared IP</i>	This interface allows you to specify a shared IP address for a reseller.
	<i>Reset Resellers</i>	This interface allows you to reset package permissions or apply Account Creation Limits (ACLs) to resellers.
	<i>View Reseller Usage and Manage Account Status</i>	This interface allows you to view your resellers' disk space and bandwidth usage.
Account Information	<i>List Suspended Accounts</i>	This feature lists your server's suspended accounts and allows you to unsuspend or terminate an account.
Account Functions	<i>Email All Users</i>	This interface enables you to email every cPanel user simultaneously.
	<i>Manage Account Suspension</i>	This feature allows you to suspend and unsuspend accounts on your server.
	<i>Show Active and Inactive Accounts</i>	This interface displays all active and inactive hosts on your server.
Multiaccount Functions	<i>Change Multiple Sites' IP Addresses</i>	This interface allows you to change the IP addresses of multiple accounts simultaneously.

	Modify/Upgrade Multiple Accounts	This interface allows you to simultaneously change the attributes of multiple accounts to use the same settings.
<i>Transfers</i>	Convert Addon Domain to Account	This interface allows you to convert an existing addon domain into a cPanel account.
<i>System Health</i>	Background Process Killer	This interface allows you to select processes that the system will terminate when the <code>u</code> <code>pcp</code> script calls the system maintenance script (<code>/scripts/maintenance</code>) every night.
<i>cPanel</i>	Modify cPanel WHM News	This feature allows you to display custom messages in your users' and resellers' cPanel & WHM interfaces.
	Reset a Mailman Password	This feature allows you to reset the password for your server's Mailman mailing list software and mailing lists.
	Synchronize FTP Passwords	This feature will attempt to repair FTP password issues.

Servers that use a cPanel Solo license will display a limited version of the following interfaces:

<i>Account Functions</i>	Create a New Account	<p>This interface allows you to create new cPanel accounts.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid #f0e68c; padding: 10px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Note: If you already own at least one account and you attempt to create an account, you will receive the following message:</p> <pre>Account Creation Status: failed Creating the account would exceed the number of licensed users. Please upgrade your license and try again.</pre> </div>
<i>Server Configuration</i>	Tweak Settings	<p>The <i>Tweak Settings</i> interface conceals the following settings:</p> <p><i>Display >> Number of accounts per page to display in "List Accounts".</i></p> <p><i>Domains >> Allow cPanel users to create subdomains across accounts</i></p> <p><i>Domains >> Allow WHM users to create subdomains across accounts</i></p>
