

# Change Password

(Dashboard >> Security >> Change Password)


## Overview

This feature allows you to change the password for your Manage2 account.

## Change your password

To change the password for your Manage2 account, perform the following steps:

1. Enter your current password in the *Current Password* text box.
2. Enter the new password in the *New Password* text box.
3. Enter the new password again in the *Verify New Password* text box.
4. Click *Change*.

## Password Generator

The *Password Generator* feature generates secure passwords, which are difficult for malicious users to guess. You can use the *Password Generator* feature in any interface that displays it.

When you click *Password Generator*, a new window appears that contains a generated password in a text box. Click *Generate Password* until it generates a satisfactory password.

To set the security requirements of the new password, perform the following steps:

1. Click *Advanced Options*.
2. Enter the desired length of the password in the *Length* text box.
3. Select whether to include uppercase letters, lowercase letters, numbers, or symbols.
4. Copy the password in a safe place and select the *I have copied this password in a safe place* checkbox at the bottom of the window.
5. Click *Use Password* to use the generated password. To reject the password and close the *Password Generator* window, click *Cancel*.
